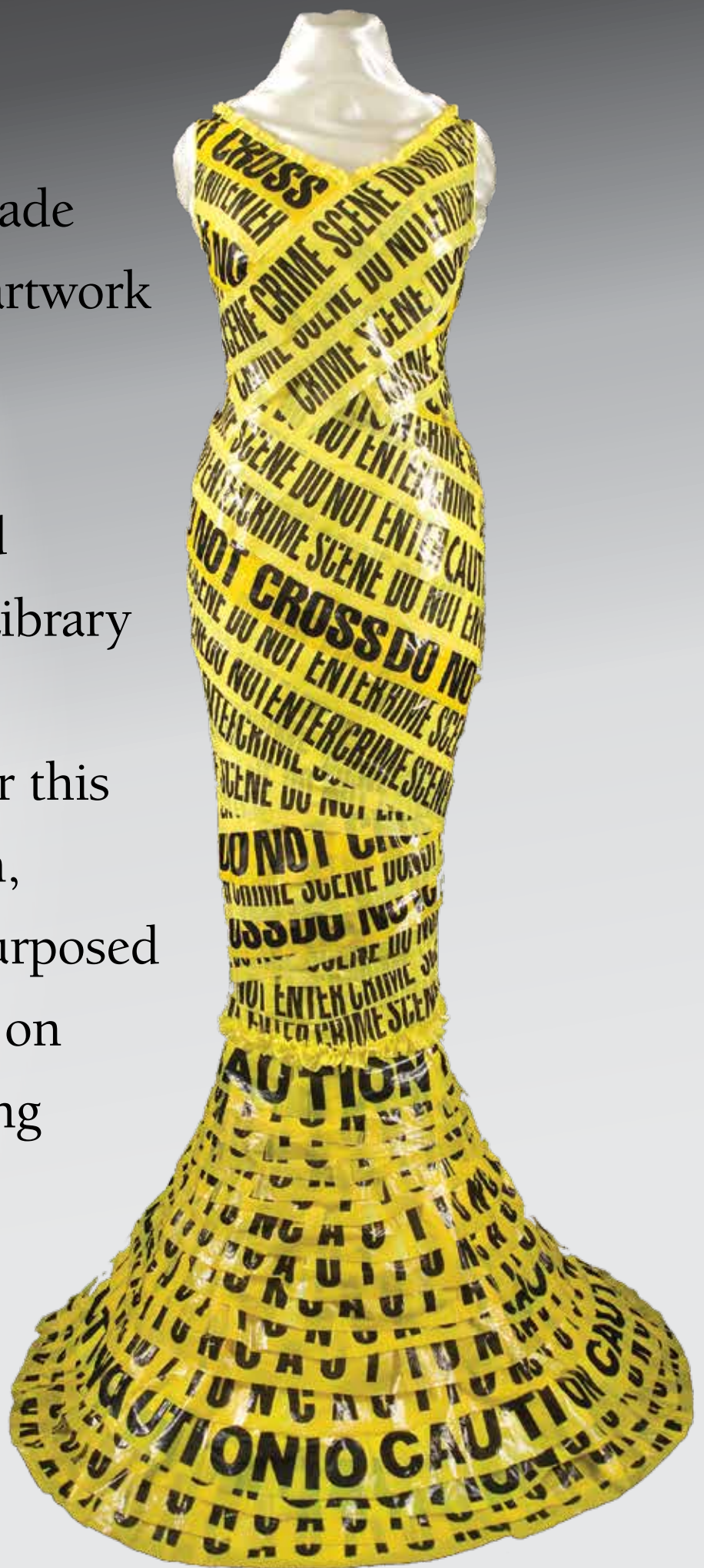


Wear Your Words

Teens created these upcycled garments made from recycled materials – artwork designed to pack a social-action punch. The Woodson Art Museum and Marathon County Public Library invited area teens to create social-action statements for this *Wear Your Words* exhibition, complementing three RePurposed & ReImagined exhibitions on view at the Museum. During four workshops, teens brainstormed slogans and created wearable artwork designed to be eye-catching and thought-provoking. During the final workshop, students met and worked with artist and environmental advocate Nancy Judd, whose *ReDress* upcycled artworks remain on view through June 15.
