Weekend Activities

If you are planning to attend the 2017 *Birds in Art* opening events, complete and return to the Museum by July 17.

- If you arrive on Thursday, you are welcome to attend a reception for Wausau-area guests. One shuttle bus will depart from the Holiday Inn & Suites at approximately 5 pm for the Museum, and depart the Museum at 7:30 pm for the hotel.
- Friday morning, “**Two Sculptors; Three Dimensions**” Karen Bondarchuk and Walter Matia offer an illustrated talk focused on the major figures in the development of Western animal sculpture – their heroines and heroes. They’ll begin with Antoine Louis Barye and the French Animalier School and move through developments in later European and American sculpture, examining both evolving styles and historical context.
- Following Friday’s welcome lunch and Master Artist Medal presentation to Don Rambadt, buses take you and your spouse/guest to the Museum for a private viewing and the artists-only Project Postcard session.
- The Friday evening reception is the official exhibition preview with dinner to follow.
- Artists, spouses/guests, and lenders to the exhibition are the Museum’s guests at dinner following the Friday evening reception.
- The receptions on Thursday and Friday nights are dressy (but not black-tie) affairs. Jacket and tie for men and cocktail dress/dress slacks for women are appropriate.
- Saturday is a busy day. Following continental breakfast at the Holiday Inn & Suites, you travel to the Museum for the Meet the Artists public opening, Don Rambadt’s Master Artist Presentation and “Artists in Action.” Around 1 pm, you leave by bus from the Museum and travel north to Hazelhurst, Wisconsin, for a relaxing afternoon and barbeque supper at the Yawkey/Woodson compound on Lake Katherine. Buses return to the hotel at approximately 9 pm.
- Bring sketchbooks, photographs, small portfolios, or electronic devices so you can take advantage of informal opportunities to share and discuss your work with others – on the bus, during breakfast at the hotel (wireless internet access is available throughout the hotel), and at Hazelhurst.
- Nametag information: Accurate spelling is critical! Please list names as you would like them to appear on your weekend nametags. This is not for any printed material, such as the catalogue, so if you prefer a less formal name or nickname, please let us know. Nametags are provided upon check-in at the hotel.
