Travel and Lodging

If you are planning to attend the 2019 *Birds in Art* opening events, complete and return to the Museum by July 8, 2019.

- Shari will make a lodging reservation for you based on information you supply on this form. Artists will stay at the Hilton Garden Inn, 2101 N. Mountain Road, Wausau, WI 54401 (715.298.5775). The Museum's reservation will hold your room for all nights that you indicate. You are welcome to stay for as long as you like, but the Museum will pay only one-room lodging costs for you and your spouse/guest for Friday and Saturday nights. If you plan to arrive earlier or stay longer, you must make arrangements to pay for those nights when you arrive at the hotel. The Museum's special rate per night is \$129.00 plus tax, check-in time is 3 pm.
- The Hilton Garden Inn is the Museum's "hospitality headquarters" on Thursday starting at approximately 10 am and again Friday morning. Museum volunteers in the Hilton Garden Inn's lobby distribute catalogues and information packets, including nametags.
- Un-sponsored meals, bar tabs, telephone calls, etc. at the hotel are each artist's responsibility and must be paid at check-out; you will be asked to provide a credit card upon check-in.
- The Museum provides all transportation during the weekend, including trips to and from the airport.
- Airlines serving Central Wisconsin Airport (CWA) are Delta, United, and American.
- If you've traveled recently, you know air travel has become increasingly expensive and harder to schedule. This is especially true when traveling into or out of Central Wisconsin Airport. When considering flight options, you might want to check flights into Minneapolis (MSP: 180 miles from Wausau), Madison (MSN: 140 miles from Wausau), Milwaukee (MKE: 211 miles from Wausau), Appleton (ATW: 95 miles from Wausau), Green Bay (GRB: 100 miles from Wausau), or Rhinelander/Oneida County (RHI: 50 miles from Wausau) and the cost of a rental car. This might yield cost-effective alternatives.
- Upon arrival on Thursday or Friday morning at CWA, you will be met by a Museum volunteer and then board a Hilton Garden Inn shuttle for transportation to the hotel. If your travel plans change at any time, please inform us immediately at 715.845.7010 or schroede@lywam.org.
- We recommend making arrangements at home for children and pets. The opening weekend activities are not appropriate for children; they may not ride the motorcoaches, participate in any Museum-sponsored meals, or go to Hazelhurst on Saturday.
