Wisconsin artist S.V. (Sue) Medaris' prints and paintings of pets and farm animals challenge viewers to consider their impressions of familiar subjects. From vivid, personality-filled portraits of towering chickens to a confrontational depiction of a snarling possum

guarding its kill, Medaris' work is instantly recognizable in *Birds in Art* exhibitions. Bold and graphic, Medaris' relief prints explore the humor, drama, and nuance inherent in humans' relationships with animals we live with, consume, and rely on.
