ACCOMMODATIONS

Artists will stay at the Hilton Garden Inn, 2101 N. Mountain Road, Wausau, WI 54401 (715-298-5775). The Museum will book your lodging reservation for you based on information you provide below.

Museum will pay for one-room lodging costs for you and your guest(s) for Thursday, Friday, and Saturday nights. If you plan to arrive earlier or stay longer, we will handle your arrangements, but you

must pay for the extra nights with the hotel. The Museum's block rate per night is \$165.00 plus tax.

Check-in time is 3 pm. Meals (other than breakfast), bar tabs, telephone calls, etc. at the hotel are each artist's responsibility and must be paid at check-out; you will be asked to provide a credit card upon check-in.


