
DAY ONE

Welcome the autumn season at the <u>Leigh Yawkey Woodson Art Museum</u> in Wausau. Surrounded by fall color, this nature-inspired museum is the perfect place to take in golden hues and artistic views. Don't miss the internationally acclaimed **Birds in Art** exhibition beginning Sept. 6.

Afterward, stretch your legs at nearby **Rib Mountain State Park**, where scenic overlooks and vibrant tree canopies steal the show.

Dine at Velveteen Plum, with cozy rooftop views and seasonal menus.

Spend the night in any of the quaint coastal towns.


DAY THREE
